

AMAAYAHUASCA

TERMS OF USE

Participation in an Amaayahuasca retreat is entirely voluntary. By joining, the participant consciously agrees to undergo traditional shamanic care offered by those responsible at Amaayahuasca and to participate in a spiritual and ceremonial program held within a traditional Amazonian context.

The participant understands that the work offered may include the voluntary consumption of medicinal plants, including the ceremonial tea known as Ayahuasca. No participant is ever obliged to consume Ayahuasca or any other plant preparation. Participation in ceremonies without ingestion is fully respected.

Amaayahuasca and its representatives will never force, pressure, or persuade any individual to drink Ayahuasca or to engage in specific practices. Each participant remains fully responsible for their own decisions and actions throughout the retreat.

The participant confirms awareness that, in Peru, traditional shamanic practices including the ceremonial use of Ayahuasca are legal and culturally protected.

HEALTH AND PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY

The participant is fully responsible for providing complete, truthful, and accurate information regarding physical, mental, and emotional health prior to arrival. This includes past or current illnesses, psychological conditions, medical treatments, medications, and substance use.

Amaayahuasca cannot be held responsible for any consequences arising from withheld, incomplete, or inaccurate information provided by the participant.

Amaayahuasca is not a medical facility. Its owners, staff, employees, and collaborators are not licensed medical doctors, psychiatrists, or psychologists. No medical diagnosis, treatment, or cure is offered.

The work provided is of a spiritual, ceremonial, and educational nature and does not replace professional medical or psychological care.

PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

All personal, medical, and spiritual information shared with Amaayahuasca is treated with strict confidentiality. Information is shared internally only with shamans or staff members when necessary for safety and care.

Amaayahuasca does not sell, trade, or share personal data with third parties. Communication is limited to information directly related to the retreat or the project.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Amaayahuasca operates with a limited number of spaces and requires significant preparation. For this reason, payments are non refundable in the event of cancellation, early departure, or non attendance.

In certain cases and at the discretion of Amaayahuasca, a voucher for missed days may be offered. Such vouchers must be used within the following calendar year and are non transferable.

PAYMENT POLICY

Payments are accepted via international bank transfer or cash. Bank transfer details are provided upon request.

In Peru, only new and undamaged banknotes are accepted. Participants are responsible for preparing appropriate cash before arrival. Access to ATMs in remote areas may be limited.
